



Dear Fellow Car Hobbyist,

The Va Association of Car Councils wanted to find a way to enforce the antique plate law. People who violate the law put our right to have a vehicle registered as an antique at risk. In order to retain our rights we need the law enforced. No enforcement could mean a more restrictive law in the future. Our thanks to Mr. Tom Cox & Mr. Fred Fann who spent many hours working towards this for the hobby.

If you spot any one violating the antique vehicle registration law by having antique plates on a vehicle being used:

1. To transport cargo (example: hauling trash to the dump)
2. As a business vehicle (example: vehicle actively used in a business or a vehicle towing lawn equipment, etc.)
3. Or a vehicle registered as an antique with a major safety violation

You can now report them by doing the following:

1. Take a photo of the vehicle and its license plate – photo should clearly show the violation (PLEASE use some common sense when you do this ... driving and picture taking is hazardous to your & other peoples health, do NOT confront people & such.)
2. Email the photo or photos to me at HarDHar@cox.net
3. Include in the email the locality (city or county where the violation occurred), date and time.
4. I will forward to our contact at the State Police who is in a leadership position and has assured us all violations will be investigated. We will only forward real violations!

As an example people using old trucks that appear in poor condition for hauling trash, cargo or for use in a business are the ones causing concern and the ones that should be reported.
